

Mantoloking & Beyond
Juried Photography Exhibition & Silent Auction
RULES

- 1) There is no entry fee to submit photographs. All images submitted must be donated to St. Simon-by-the-Sea's Silent Auction to benefit the ongoing restoration of our historic buildings. In addition to themed photographs, we have added a Centennial category and a Youth category (photographers 18 and under).
- 2) Color, black and white and creatively enhanced photographs will be accepted. Digital and film photographs will be accepted. The preferred print size is 8"x10" or 8"x12". The print surface may be matte or glossy finish. Any manipulation of the photograph must be the work of the photographer. All prints must be made via archival quality print permanence papers, inks & printing methods. See notes below regarding how to achieve archival quality print permanence.
- 3) All photographs must be mounted on archival quality acid free mat board or foam core and over-matted in archival quality acid free white or off-white mat. The outer dimensions of the mat must be no larger than 16"x20", and no smaller than 8"x10". No double matting and no frames are permitted. Both horizontal and vertical orientation images will be accepted. See notes below regarding local galleries/framers that will mat and mount work for you.
- 4) All images, recent or old, must be the original work of the photographer. We encourage photographers to SIGN, DATE and when appropriate TITLE the photograph in pencil on the BACK of the mat. Photographers may submit more than one print. The submitted images qualify for the following awards: First Place, Second Place, Third Place, and Ten Honorable Mentions. There will also be a separate display of historical photographs not eligible for ribbons.
- 5) The deadline for submissions is Sunday July 22nd, 2012. Matted and mounted work must be delivered to Jane Post, 4 Carpenter Lane, Mantoloking with the show entry form (see PDF) attached to the reverse of the work. All images MUST have the NAME of the photographer printed legibly and if appropriate, an indication of the top of the photograph.
- 6) St. Simon-by-the-Sea reserves the right to display submissions at its discretion.
- 7) Images that do not sell at the Silent Auction will be available for pickup at Jane Post's house between 9AM and 4PM Monday, July 30th, 2012.
